



Prohibited use of Digital Devices Policy

APPROVED 2019-12-12

1. DIGITAL DEVICES IN THE DRESSING ROOM

- 1.1 The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) believes some of these uses constitute an invasion of an individual's personal privacy. This will not be tolerated by the OHF.
- 1.2 In growing numbers, these devices are being manufactured with cameras that allow photographs and video to be taken and shared electronically, without permission, during regular hockey activities in change rooms, shower areas, and/or bathrooms. If someone uses a device this way and captures a photo or video image, this may constitute a violation of personal privacy but may also be a criminal offence.
- 1.3 The OHF prohibits the use of any form of Camera, Video Camera, Camera Phone, or other portable digital device in any recreational facility change rooms for the purposes of taking photographs or videos unless permission has been granted by the President or designate of the appropriate Member.
- 1.4 These devices may be used for personal music or playing team music.
- 1.5 It is the team officials' responsibility to monitor and control the uses of such devices. Any complaints with regards to the policy not being adhered to shall be investigated by the appropriate Member.
