

Free skate - coaches should skate among players talking to as many as possible - make them feel comfortable, help as needed. Give parents time to get kids on ice for first time.



- 4) Combination Narrow / Wide













Drill Name & Description Skating Warm Up

Skating Skills Warm - Up

After dividing the ice into four lanes length wise, skaters will lineup at each end of the ice in lanes 1 & 3 at one end and 2 & 4 at the other. Skaters leave one by one working on different skating techniques down the length of the ice before entering the next line.


