Purpose

To establish age requirements for Coaches, Managers, and Trainers participating in Minor Hockey, ensuring they are of appropriate maturity and experience relative to the players they are working with.

Policy

- To be rostered as a Coach (Head Coach/Assistant Coach) in Minor Hockey, participants must be a minimum of 16 years of age as of December 31st in the current season and at least two (2) years older than the age division of the Team they are registered with.
- To be rostered as a Manager in Minor Hockey, participants must be a minimum of 18 years of age as of December 31st in the current season and at least two (2) years older than the age division of the Team they are registered with.
- To be rostered as a Trainer in Minor Hockey, participants must be a minimum of 19 years of age as of December 31st in the current season and at least two (2) years older than the age division of the Team they are registered with.
- In Junior Hockey, participants may be rostered without this age requirement so long as it is approved by the NOJHL.
