Role of the NOHA Council Director

In addition to the roles and responsibilities identified within the NOHA By-Laws, the following is a high-level overview of the role of the District Council Director:

- Represent its District, while also representing and acting in the best interest of, the NOHA as a whole;
- Promotion of NOHA programming;
- Understand and interpret the NOHA, OHF and Hockey Canada Constitutions;
- Attendance at NOHA Meetings – typically from September to May – every 6 or 7 weekends. Attendance on planned virtual meetings on an as-needed basis;
- Attendance at Association meetings when invited;
- Attend NOHA Tournament of Champions in your District;
- Member of NOHA Committees (generally 2);
- Follow-up with Associations to ensure that timelines are met;
- Appoint the District Referee-in-Chief annually;
- Address inquiries in a timely fashion that are received from Associations and Members in your District;
- Providing reports to Associations regarding initiatives from the NOHA, OHF and Hockey Canada;
- Attend OHF Championship, if required.

Note that this is a volunteer position, however all travel, accommodations, and other expenses relating to the position shall be covered by the NOHA.

The NOHA By-Laws provide additional details regarding the roles and responsibilities of the NOHA Board of Directors, including the District Council Directors.
