Events

- Main evaluation Camp from January 4-6, 2024, in North Bay.
- The Ontario Winter Games, hosted in Thunder Bay from February 22-25, 2024.
There is travel involved and therefore additional day(s) will be required before and after the event to get to and from Thunder Bay.

General

The Assistant Coaches must be Development 1 “Trained.” Priority will be given to coaches who have High Performance 1.

The candidate must have Respect in Sport – Activity Leader or Speak Out Certification and the Gender Diversity Course. The candidate must have a valid Criminal Record Check with VSS. The candidate must have Instructional Stream – Checking Skills 1 (if required with club team).

 - Post-Game Analysis Plan
 - Tactical Play
 - Special Teams
- In cooperation with the NOHA Technical Director, Head Coach, and other Assistant Coaches, provide feedback on the players that will be competing for Team NOHA.
- In cooperation with the Head Coach and other Assistant Coaches, assist in the creation and execution of practice plans that will be used at each event.
- Shall run either the forwards or defencemen on the bench.
- In cooperation with the Head Coach and other Assistant Coaches, is responsible for the supervision of the players at all times when they are together as an official group.
- In cooperation with the Head Coach, other Assistant Coaches and in consultation with the NOHA Technical Director plans and conducts all on-ice and off-ice activities.
- The candidate must be able to work effectively with the Head Coach, Volunteers, other Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Players, and Parents.
